



Love Mass- “Gotta Know Info”



Our Kindergarten Love Mass will be held twice. The first one will be on February 8th. This is an all-school mass. It is an excellent opportunity for the students to “rehearse” the mass held for our families. Parents should try to avoid coming on the 8th if possible. We want you to enjoy the mass for the first time, together with us. The second mass will be held on February 10th and will begin at 8:15. Parents and extended family are invited!

Students are asked to bring in a baby gift, such as a blanket, bottles, diapers, etc. These donations will be taken up during the mass offertory. Later the gifts will be sent to the Pregnancy Resource Center. Please make sure your child’s name is on the gift. These donations are not to be wrapped.

The students will perform a few songs after mass has ended. At this time, photographs and video will be permitted. It will definitely be a moment meant to be captured!

A reception will be held in the cafeteria following our mass. Students will be dismissed at the end of the mass to their parents. Students will then escort parents to the cafeteria through the front of the school, by the school office. Please let us know in advance if you will not be able to attend. The reception usually lasts until 10:15-10:30.

Students will be allowed to change into PJs following the reception. Parents are asked to assist. Students will remain in their pajamas the rest of the day. Parents are asked to take the child’s good clothes home. Students may wear slippers, but play shoes should be left at school for the child to wear at recess.

We will begin our Valentine Party at 1:15. Parents are invited to join us for more fun! It will be a great way to end our special day. We hope you can join us for both special events.

It is a very special day for each student. We encourage you to be here to help celebrate your child’s love for God and his/her great efforts in the mass.

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- ✓ On Feb. 8th, during the school mass, students should be in school uniform and are asked to wear their Kindergarten sweatshirts.
- ✓ On Feb. 10th students should wear their Sunday best (dresses, nice pants, shirts etc.).
- ✓ During the reception, please be sure you and your child have your picture taken. See your teacher before changing into your pajamas!
- ✓ Please be sure to let us know, **in advance**, if you will not be attending mass or the reception.
- ✓ Please be sure your child's baby gift is sent in by Friday, February 3rd. Thank you in advance for your contribution.
