

Stations of the Cross Project Guidelines

Objective: To create a video depicting the Stations of the Cross by using Windows Movie Maker.

Materials Needed: Flashdrive, digital photographs and music appropriate for depicting the Stations of the Cross, access to Windows Movie Maker on a PC*, & PC compatible microphone*

(* Access to a PC and microphone will be provided during class if not available at home.)

Due Date: **March 30th, 2010**

Project Guidelines:

- Students may work independently or with one partner on this project. (Some classes will be allowed a group of three if there are an odd number of students in the class.)
- It is assumed that the majority of this project will be completed outside of school. Some class time will be spent reviewing parts of the project and recording some of the narration. Time after school may also be provided by Mr. Huelsman for students wishing to complete their projects before the due date. (This must be setup with Mr. Huelsman at least two days in advance with written permission from a parent.)
- Students will be creating a digital slideshow-video depicting the Stations of the Cross. Pictures collected for this project should fall into one of three areas: Traditional, Modern Interpretation, or Original/Self-Taken. Students will be shown examples of all three types and can mix and match according to their personal depiction of the stations. All pictures must be appropriate in depicting and setting the proper mood for the Stations of the Cross.
- All videos must also be accompanied with some sort of sound. This can be either personal narration or song accompaniment, but it is preferred that both are used for full credit. Narration and music must be appropriate in depicting and setting the proper mood for the Stations of the Cross.
- All videos must have a Title page, Introductions to each Station, and Credits page. The Title page must include the names of the students who created the video. The Credits page must include a reference to every source that was used to gather pictures, narration, or music.
