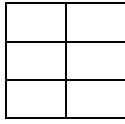


1. Your poster will be divided into six squares so it looks like this:



2. Fill in each square with 4-8 well-written, descriptive sentences and colorful pictures (hand drawn or printed off a computer). Use the computer to write your sentences and glue your sentences onto the poster board under your picture. Here's what you will put in each square:

1st square (top left corner) – Title Square. Include the name of your region (Pacific Northwest Region, Desert Southwest and West Region, Plains, Eastern Woodlands, or Artic), your name, your number and HR. Your picture you use should be a “map” picture showing the location of your region on the U.S map. Also include specific names of groups to your region – example: Iroquois, Navajo. Have at least two groups, but you can have more. Page 61 in your SS text is a great place to look.

2nd square (top right corner) – Geography & Climate. What is the weather like in your region? What are the summers like? What are the winters like? What is the land like (mountainous, flat and grassy, forests, etc.) What bodies of water are there (ocean, lakes, rivers, etc.)? Write at least four good sentences. Check spelling and grammar carefully. Include a nice and neat picture that shows what the region looks like.

3rd square (left middle) – Major Resources. What natural materials were available to tribes of your region? Why were these resources important to the tribes of your region? Write at least four good sentences. Check spelling and grammar carefully! Include nice and neat pictures of the resources!

4th square (right middle) – Food. What kinds of foods did people of your region eat? How did they get this food? Again, write at least four good sentences and include nice and neat pictures of the people getting the food or pictures of the food itself.

5th square (bottom left corner) – Shelter (homes). What kinds of homes did your people live in? What kinds of materials were used in the making of these homes? Write at least four well-written sentences and nice, neat pictures.

6th square (bottom right corner) – Art – Include a picture of their art such as basket weaving, pottery, wampum belts, architecture, or totem poles. Write at least three sentences about their art work. Write what the art was used for and what it was made of.

3. Include a Resource page. You can type your resources and glue/tape them to the back of your poster. Keep the resource page simple. If you use a website, write the website. If you use a book, write the title of the book and the author.
