Our Program



St. Gabriel Sunday Morning Preschool provides Lectionary - based catechesis for the early faith development of 3,4, & 5 year olds. A variety of modes are used to engage children in stories from the Gospel each week.

Requirements

Child must be three years old by September 1st of the beginning of the school year attending. Child must be fully potty-trained. Each child's readiness for the program will be addressed by the Sunday School staff within the first month of classes.

Arrival & Departure

Parents and guardians must sign their child(ren) "in" upon arrival. If you are not attending Mass you must leave a number where you can be reached. The sign in sheet is located in your child's classroom. Each child should always be left in the care of a staff member. Do not leave child(ren) in an unattended classroom.

Please pick you child up immediately after Mass. The catechists are volunteers who give of their time and talent during the Mass to teach these classes. Please be courteous and ***do not leave your child(ren) for any length of time following the Mass.***

Registration Fees & Supplies

A registration fee of \$15.00 per child/\$30 per family is due at enrollment. This fee is charged no matter when the child enrolls. This fee helps defray the cost of the weekly lectionary supplement given to each child and other activities scheduled.

Your child may be asked to bring specific supplies (such as glue, crayons, etc.) These items are brought in by individual classroom requests.

Classroom Behavior & Rules

Children are expected to maintain their best behavior during class. If a child is continually disruptive or uncooperative this takes away from all of the children in the class. Any behavior that hurts another child (physically or otherwise) will not be tolerated. A conference will be arranged with parent(s) to talk about the best plan of action.

Children are expected to follow these basic rules:

- Be courteous
- Talk softly inside
- Share with friends
- Be fair, take turns
- Keep feet and hands to self
