New Business:

- Audit Committee Adrian Warfield presented that a committee of three people has been formed to focus on the financials of St. Gabriel and will cover all internal controls of all accounts held by St. Gabriel
- Eric Schrenger told the council of some Catholic Church communication tools that were located on internet that helps with providing daily education about Catholicism:

Worship – presented by Barbara Harbsmeier – 1) Christmas decorations were beautiful – we applaud the Arts and Environment Committee; the Arts and Environment committee is looking into banners for outside that can be changed seasonally; 2) Therese Brennan has RCIA welcoming on Sunday, January 15, 2017 and they will have Reconciliation on January 29, 2017; 3) We are changing the intersessions at daily Masses – they will not be vocal anymore, but silent and in your mind instead; 4) Steve Bennett had the first Eucharistic Ministers' training – ten people came to the class; 5) Deacon Stephen Bowling is working on Roman Missal Nuggets that he will schedule beginning in Lent
